### **POSITION SUMMARY**

Eastside Catholic High School is seeking a Government/Law & Society teacher for a long-term substitute position for the fourth quarter of the 2018-19 school year. The position consists of two high school AP American Government classes, three Law & Society (Street Law) classes and one mentor/homeroom class. In AP Government, the teacher would guide the students through final preparations for taking the AP Government exam on May 6, 2019. For the Law & Society classes, the teacher will provide instruction on topics related to criminal and civil law as students work through the Street Law textbook.
