HEALTH AND SAFETY FOR VISITORS

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, Eastside Catholic is taking additional precautions to protect the health of our campus community and visitors. Please review the protocols below:

- All visitors are required to wear masks on the Eastside Catholic campus. Please make sure to put your mask on upon exiting your vehicle. Physical distancing at a minimum of 6 feet from staff and other visitors is encouraged.
- We cannot accommodate walk-in visitors for individual meetings, presentations or tours. We are limiting the traffic through our office to protect the health of our staff.
- Please do not come to our campus if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19 or have had contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive positive for COVID-19.
- While we are taking all precautions to safeguard our community, we cannot eliminate the risk of COVID-19 exposure and infection on campus. Please remember that you visit at risk to your own health. If any visitor shows symptoms and tests positive for COVID-19 within 48 hours of visiting campus, please report it to us by contacting COVID-19 Coordinator [Kristin Kracht](#).

Registered Visitors for On-Campus Tours

Arrival Time

Please arrive no earlier than 15 minutes before your scheduled presentation and campus tour to limit the amount of time inside our building.

COVID Screening

Upon check-in, you will be given a COVID-19 screening questionnaire and your temperature will be taken. Please review the questionnaire (below) in advance. If you are experiencing any of these symptoms currently or answer "yes" to any of these questions, we ask that you reschedule your visit.

Guests

Your guest count at time of visit registration is the only number of guests we can accommodate. No additional visitors will be allowed due to physical distancing space constraints. Students can bring **no more than three guests** with them for the visit. All groups are limited to **four total people**.

Distancing

Please stay at least six feet from our staff and other visitors at all times.

Materials

All materials are pre-packaged and set out in advance for you. Our staff is cleaning and disinfecting the entire presentation room between visits.

Restrooms

Our public restrooms will be available for use. We strongly encourage abiding by public health guidelines, including washing your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or using hand sanitizer when hand washing is unavailable.

COVID-19 Questionnaire

These are the questions you will be asked upon check-in for your visit.

1. Are you currently experiencing any of the following: temperature of 100 degrees or higher, cough, shortness of breath or chest tightness?
2. Are you currently experiencing two or more of the following: chills, fatigue, lost of taste or smell, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea?
3. Have you been exposed to or in contact with anyone who has tested positive or is a presumptive positive for COVID-19?
4. Have you been exposed to or in contact with anyone showing symptoms of COVID-19?
