All ECMS students will need the following:

- 1 combination lock for locker
- 1 three-ring binder (either 1.5" or 2") with tabs for each class
- Notebook paper
- 1 pencil pouch
- Lenovo school-issued laptop and stylus
- Lenovo school-issued laptop charger (any brand compatible charger works)
- No. 2 pencils
- Ink pens (red, black and blue)
- 3 highlighters
- 1 box of colored pencils or markers
- 1 metric ruler with metal blade
- 1 package 3" x 5" index cards
- 1 package 3" x 3" post-it notes
- 1 journal of student's choosing, can be a spiralbound notebook (for Religious Studies)
- [1 Nu Board \(all math classes\)](#), **students must have this specific item.** No substitutions.
- 1 scientific calculator: Texas Instruments TI-30XII Scientific Calculator (keep in your pencil pouch); *this item is not required for Math Foundations class*
- Face masks (We will be following CDC and WA state guidelines, which may include requiring masks for all students and adults.)
- For PE:
Shoes: Running, tennis, basketball or cross-trainers
Uniform PE tops: t-shirt (modest fitting, nothing too tight or oversized), EC sweatshirt/jersey, rain jacket for inclement weather
Bottoms: shorts (mid-thigh length or longer), sweatpants and/or leggings/yoga-style pants with a long shirt

The following supplies are needed for specific grade levels or specific courses, as applicable.

All 6th Grade Students

- 1 package index cards 3" x 5" (for World Languages; students in SOAR or EMC do not need this item)
- 1 Composition notebook, not spiralbound (for Science)
- 1 1" black 3-ring binder (for Music class*)

*Nothing else is required for first week of Music class. Students will explore all instrument options before selecting an instrument. Once selected, students will need: *Essential Elements - Book 1* for their instrument and an instrument rented at a music store. Parents should contact [Mr. Boysen](#) if their student has already selected an instrument.

All 8th Grade Students

- 1 composition notebook, not spiralbound (for Humanities)
- 3 packages of 1.5" x 2" post-it notes (for Humanities)
- 1 pair of earbud headphones (for Humanities and World Languages)

- Prisma color pencils (12 set)

- Binder dividers with pockets
 - Recommended dividers: [Avery Big Tab Insertable Plastic Dividers, two-tone colors, two pockets, 5-tab set](#) (#11982)
 - As students have seven classes, parents may want to buy two 5-packs
- Binder: 1.5-inch to 2-inch
 - Recommended binder: [Avery Heavy-Duty View Binder with 1.5-inch one touch, EZD ring, black](#) (#79695)
 - Students should not get a binder larger than 2 inches; this binder will be used for all classes
- At-Home Paper Station - Mobile Hanging File
 - Recommended Hanging File system: [Pendaflex Hanging Organizer, All-in-1 Wall Organizer/Pocket Chart, Black with Bright Color Folders, Poly Carry Case, Letter Size](#) (#52891)
 - File folders and shoe box are an acceptable alternative
