



2018-19 UNIFORM GUIDELINES

- Middle school students are required to be in uniform at school unless otherwise noted.
- All uniform items must be purchased from Lands' End with the embroidered school logo. The only exceptions are the uniform sweatshirts which are sold in the school spirit store, Orange Crush.
- Polo shirts come in orange and navy and there are several styles within the ECMS policy from which to choose.
- There are also several styles of khaki and navy blue pants and shorts available within the ECMS policy, as well as a skirt, skort and dress option for girls.
- Any combination of orange or navy uniform polo shirt and khaki or navy uniform bottoms are permitted any day of the week.
- The uniform sweatshirt is meant as outerwear for warmth; students must wear their uniform polo shirt underneath.
- Shoes with wheels are not allowed.
- On Fridays, unless otherwise noted, students celebrate school spirit and are allowed to wear jeans, athletic shorts or other pants along with EC Spirit Wear -- a top from the Orange Crush or an EC sports team.
- Tights or leggings in a solid color may be worn under skirts and dresses
- All garments must be clean and neat in appearance and not ripped or torn, including jeans on Spirit and Free Dress Days.
- Hats and sunglasses are not allowed inside any school building.

Additionally, on non-uniform days and all school-related events:

- Tank tops, and clothing revealing midriff or chest are not allowed.
- Skirts and shorts must touch the top part of the knee.
- Pajama pants, yoga pants, and leggings worn as pants are not allowed.
